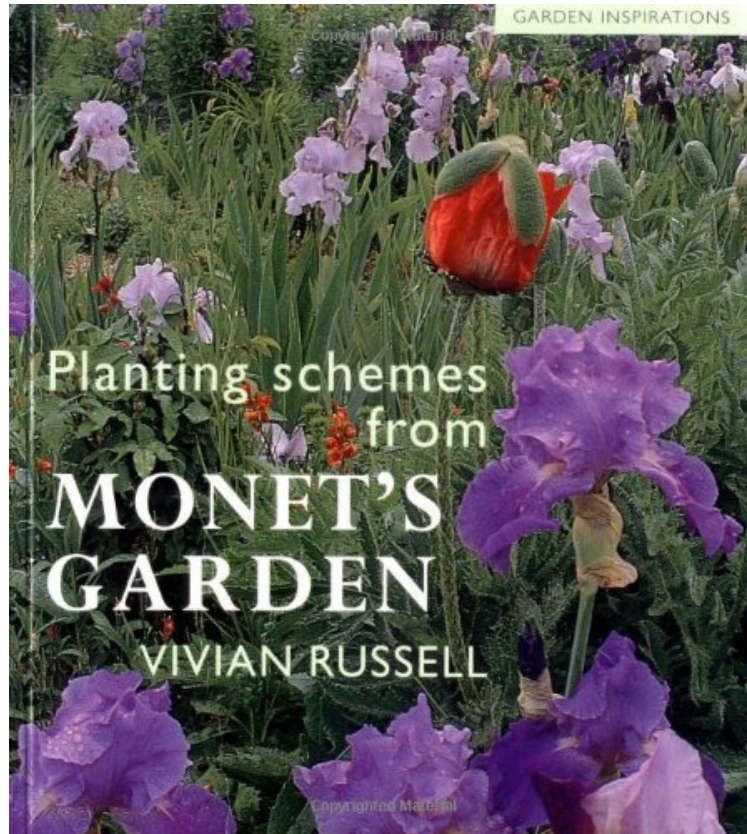

I was looking for a reference book of Monet's gardens. Like the other reviewer, I, too, should have paid more attention to the description of the book's dimensions. The photos were small and did not show off the gardens as I had expected. For a much better book although it, too, is small, is MONET'S GARDENS at GIVERNY by Elizabeth Murray. This is only a postcard-size book (smaller than the one being reviewed), but I did, however, get a better sense of the gardens for my paintings. What's neat about these photos is that they are from the same vantage point as many of Monet's paintings. It's a much better reference.

I bought this book as a present for my wife who is a Monet devotee. I guess I should have looked at the book description a little closer. I was expecting a normal size picture book like all her other Monet books. The format was disappointing and not nearly as nice as the many other garden books on the subject.

This volume reveals the ideas and planting schemes that underpin Monet's garden at Giverny so that readers can replicate them. A short introduction to Giverny is followed by color photographs, with detailed captions describing the plants and techniques that make up the garden.
