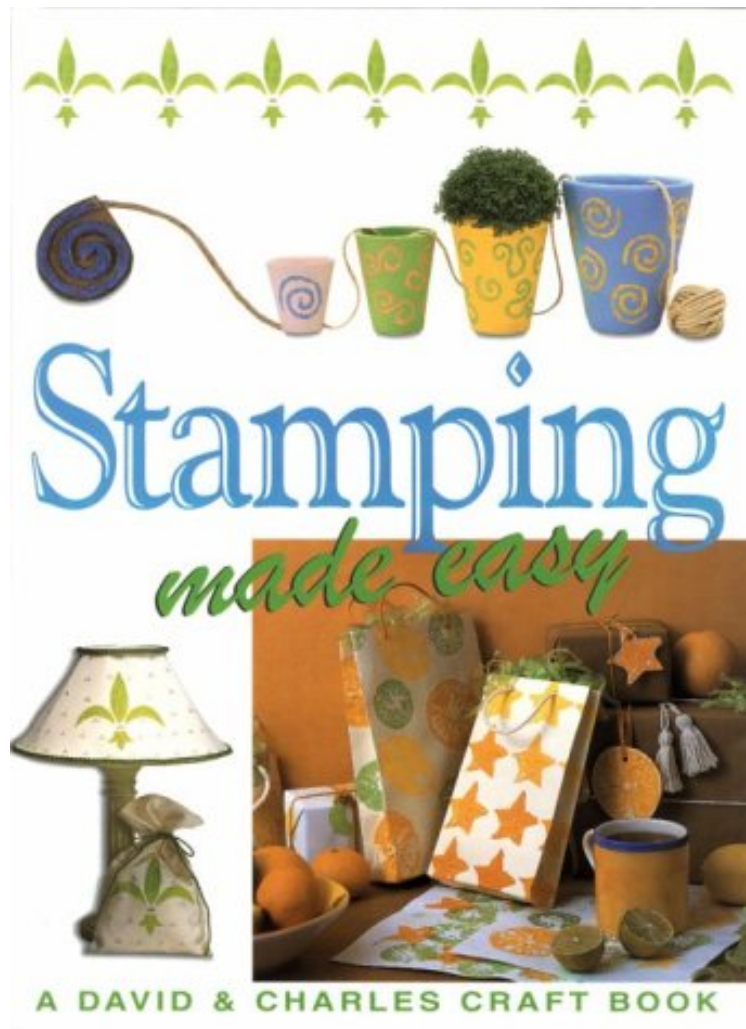

For crafters looking to indulge in stamping without the investment, this little guide offers a simple solution: make your own. Cork, sponges, erasers, foam, string, leaves, fruits, vegetables, even ceiling tile all make great stamps. The authors supply patterns for all their hand-cut stamps, which they sprinkle liberally over paper, fabric, ceramic tile, and wood to create pillows, lampshades, a baby quilt, a chair cover, ornaments, scarves, and other wearables and small home accessories. The introductory section covers making the stamps and hints on working with them; the 10 projects include full directions for creating the items that need sewing or gluing. This is a good introduction to the subject for those who want to try it out without spending much money. --Amy Handy
